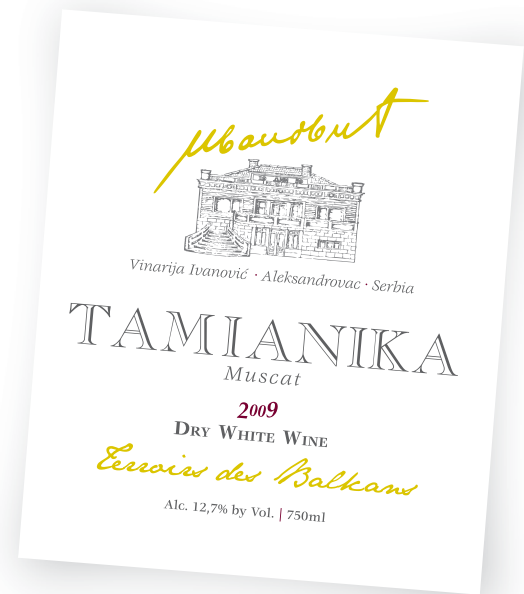


# TAMIANIKA

Dry White Wine



## Wine description:

If Prokupac is the King of Župa, then Tamianika must be his Queen.

Divine wine, straw-yellowish color with green glow, with characteristic Muscat taste and smell carrying a combination of spicy tones of incense, cinnamon, basil and fruit tones of pineapple and strawberry.

It's well suited for fish and sea food.

Composition: Largely a silicon, chalk and clay mixture, with parts almost pure chalk

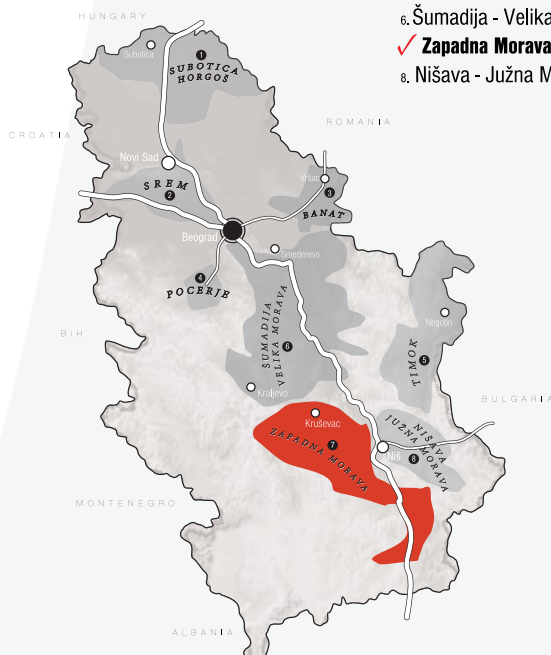
## Vinification

Winemaker: Dragoslav Ivanovic  
Fermentation: Fermented in closed temperature controlled Stainless Steel fermenters  
Yeasts: Wild Yeasts

## Maturation

Barrels: None - stainless steel tanks  
Period: Bottled 5-6 months after fermentation is completed  
Wine purification: Fine with Bentonite, no filtering
